



## Year 6 Residential Trip 2024 at PGL, Liddington, Wiltshire

Dear Parent/Carers,

Next year, the year 6 residential trip will take place from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2024 to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Following the success of this year's residential, we are delighted to have again secured a booking with PGL at their multi-activity site in Liddington, Wiltshire. An extract from their website reads:

*'All PGL's adventure activities take place under the instruction and guidance of specially trained PGL instructors who prioritise safety above all else. Activities take place on land, on the water and in the air (for our rope-based challenges), so each brings a different (and fun!) way for children to challenge themselves in a friendly, safe and supportive environment.'*

The residential trip is one of the highlights of the children's final year at primary school and provides so many positive experiences and benefits for the children: the chance to challenge themselves and achieve incredible things; the opportunity to socialise with their friends and to grow positive relationships prior to secondary school; the chance to develop independence and a platform to thrive beyond the classroom.

Whilst residential trips are, of course, optional, we believe that they are an invaluable experience for all children and we would love for every child in the year group to attend.

The cost of the visit will be approximately £500 and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. To confirm our booking, an initial deposit of £50 per child will be required by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. This deposit is non-refundable. Please make payment using SCOpay.

We will be holding a parents' evening on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> September in 6P to present to you in more detail the exciting range of activities available at PGL.
