

PE and Sport

- *PE will be on* <u>*Wednesdays*</u> for Autumn 1.
- Children will take part in the 'Golden Mile' during Enrichment Tuesday.
- Children need to wear their full PE kit to school (both outdoor and indoor) on Tuesday and Wednesdays.
- Please ensure all jewellery is removed on a PE day and if earrings cannot be removed they must be taped over.



PPA Cover Teachers

- The year 4 teacher's PPA time will be every Tuesday morning in Autumn. In this time your child will be taught by a different member of teaching staff.
- Lessons will be on a 3-week rotation. Your child will have 3 weeks in a row of one area and then classes will swap over.

Subject areas include: Art and DT (Mrs Nile) Music and French (Mrs Whiting) Geography (Mrs Chappelow)

Times tables

- We will again be taking part in the National Multiplication Check (MTC).
- 25 questions with each question given a 6 sec time limit.
- Results are not published formally, but will be shared individually with you after completion.

In preparation, please support your child by:

• Encouraging regular practice of times tables on TT Rockstars.

Phonics and Reading

- In class, children will continue to use phonics to support them with reading and spelling.
- At Frimley, we use Essential Letters and Sounds (ELS) systematic phonics approach across the school.
- Some children, who may need additional support, will attend a phonics intervention group with Mrs Djeneralovic, and will be allocated a decodable reading book in addition to their colour book banded book.
- If your child receives one of these books, it is really important that they read this book as it will reinforce the learning covered in their phonics group.



Home Learning

Home learning will be set weekly.

Why do we set home learning?

- Develops independence
- Develops good learning habits
- Helps children to remember things
- Can improve time management and organisation
- Develops positive attitudes towards learninglearning occurs beyond the classroom
- Gives children additional time to learn and remember things


Evidence tells us that children who do homework make on average 3+ months more progress than their peers.

How you can help:

- Have a dedicated space for your child to do homework and structures help- make it the same time each week if possible.
- Praise your child for their efforts.
- Contact your child's teacher if you are concerned about any aspect of homework.

Lifelong Learners

The Frimley Learner passport supports the development of the attributes required to be a Frimley Learner. The passport aims to encapsulate who your child is, captures their achievements throughout the year, encourages self-reflection and celebrates their successes.



Frimley Learner Passports

Children work towards becoming an Ultimate Frimley Learner by demonstrating the different attributes inside and outside of school.

With the teacher, they sign off when they feel they have achieved a particular task. When they have had 4 activities signed off (in an attribute), they then complete both extended reflection tasks.

When all attributes have been completed, the child earns the Ultimate Frimley Learner badge.



Behaviour

Our emphasis remains on:

- Celebrating the successes of our children
- Focusing on positivity; the praising and reinforcement of good behaviour and good work ethic
- Closely linking praise with our school values
- Earning rewards, both individually and collaboratively

We have a set of Golden Rules, again linked to our school values. Children will continue to earn points for themselves and their House teams. These are called **Praise Points**.
