Over the past couple of years, we have started to raise the profile of careers and the world of work at Frimley – highlights last year included a careers day and several STEM ambassador visits.

Two of the key parts of our careers provision are as follows:

- To provide children with the opportunity to build and develop their future aspirations.
- To broaden children's understanding of different career paths and opportunities available to them.

This year, we are looking at providing children with meaningful experiences linked to their learning in the curriculum so that they can see the 'bigger picture' and understand how their learning today links to the real world.

With this in mind, I am asking for volunteers from our school community who would be willing to come into school to share what they do with the children. Previously, we have found that interactive sessions (about 30 minutes) with short tasks or equipment/artefacts to show really engage the children.

The areas we are looking to provide sessions for throughout this year are below:

- A career/job related to geography in the local area
- A career/job related to children's learning on electricity in science
- An animator
- A historian or a job in the history field
- An illustrator
- A career/job linked to product design
- A career/job linked to climate change.
