## Year 3- Butser Farm Trip Wednesday 10th January 2024

Dear Parents & Carers,

We have booked a trip to Butser Ancient Farm on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> January to support our learning in History about the Stone Age to the Iron Age. Butser Ancient Farm is an open-air experimental archaeology museum and research centre, where we will be stepping back in time for the day to learn more about our past. During the day, we will be exploring buildings, technologies, and animals from the ancient past as well as taking part in an archaeological dig, handling different artefacts from this period, making jewellery, and doing some chalk carving. The cost of the trip will be £24. Please make payment through your SCO pay account.

In view of the time of year, which is likely to be very cold, children need to be dressed appropriately! As the site is situated on the side of a windy hill, children **must** wear the correct clothing as we will be outside, in the elements, all day.

- **Footwear** should be either **old** trainers, warm boots or wellies.
- <u>Clothing: 2 layers</u> of trousers/tights/leggings 2 pairs of socks and then many layers on top vest, t-shirt, long sleeve top, jumper and then a waterproof jacket to protect them from the elements.
- <u>Scarves, gloves, coats and hats will also be vital!</u>

### It is very important that the children have correct attire as it will be cold!

<u>All</u> children will need a packed lunch, a snack and 2 drinks in a rucksack with their name on. Butser Farm encourage children to take any rubbish home with them, as there are not lots of facilities to dispose of rubbish there.

Children will not require any money, as we will not be visiting the shop: the children will be bringing home their own crafts made, at no extra cost.

We shall be leaving school at around 9am and aiming to return at 3.15pm, traffic permitting. The journey there and back will be approximately an hour. Please ensure your child has taken travel sickness tablets if required beforehand and please inform the class teacher if your child has any issues with travelling by coach.
