
Notes and reminders

Maths

This term we will be building on our understanding of arrays and the link between repeated addition and multiplication. We will also explore the link with grouping and sharing in division. We will be recapping the 2,5 and 10 times tables before moving on to the 3, 4 and 8 times tables. We will then be moving on to learning about measurements including length and perimeter.

Writing

This term in writing we will be using the picture book 'Stone Age Boy' to write our own narratives about the Bronze or Iron Age. We will then write a set of instructions about how to make prehistoric jewellery. We will then bring them to life using Clips to turn them into an instructional video.

RE

In RE we will be learning about how worship shows what is important to Muslims.



PSHE

In PSHE we will be exploring how our bodies change during growing up and why these changes are important and necessary.

History

This term in History we will be learning all about Prehistory and exploring how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

French

In French we will be learning the numbers 1-31 as well as the days of the week and the months of the year.

PE

We will be playing basketball in PE this half term.

Music

In Music we will be learning about the history of music and what music was like in the Renaissance Era.

Science

In Science we will be investigating different rock types and soils. We will be comparing and grouping different kinds of rocks by their appearance and physical characteristics.
