



Year 3- Butser Farm Trip Wednesday 10th January 2024

Dear Parents & Carers,

Next Wednesday 10th January, we will be going on our trip to Butser Ancient Farm to support our learning in History about the Stone Age to the Iron Age. As Butser Ancient Farm is an open-air museum, we will be spending the duration of the day outside so we wanted to remind you about a few things before the trip. It is likely to be cold and wet on the day so please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately.

- **Footwear:** please can your child bring a pair of trainers to wear on the coach and a pair of warm boots or wellies in a plastic bag to wear whilst on the Farm.
- **Clothing:** Trousers/leggings, a pair of warm socks, lots of layers on top (vest, t- shirt, long sleeve top and jumper) and a waterproof jacket to protect themselves from the elements.
- **Warm gloves and hats are also encouraged!**

All children will need a packed lunch, a snack and 2 drinks in a rucksack with their name on. Butser Farm encourage children to take any rubbish home with them, as there are not lots of facilities to dispose of rubbish there.

Children will not require any money, as we will not be visiting the shop. The children will be bringing home their own crafts made during the day at no extra cost.

We shall be leaving school at around 9am and aiming to return at 3.15pm, traffic permitting. Please ensure your child has taken travel sickness tablets if required beforehand and please inform the class teacher if your child has any issues with travelling by coach.

If you have not yet paid for the trip, please could you do so via SCO Pay by this Friday 5th January. The cost of the trip is £24.
