At the end of the 2 -week unit, they will be 'quizzed' on the 8 listed words plus 2 mystery words that follow the fortnightly rule. They will have the chance to receive praise points during the quiz. Some children may be given a different list of words to take home that their teacher believes will support their individual learning journey. # How can I practise my spellings at home? 

Here are some useful ideas, games and web links to help your child practise their spellings at home.

5. Acrostic Poems - Create an acrostic poem for 5 of your words. Example: snow: Soft and fluffy, Never warm, Open the door, Wade in the cold
6. Make a Wordsearch - Make a wordsearch using a grid of all your spelling words. Come back and find your words.
7. Look, Cover, Write, Check - Look at the spelling Cover the spelling up Write it down Check to see if it's correct
8. Highlight it! - Write the words using a different colour for the parts that follow the same pattern or rule (e.g. silent letters: Knight, Knee, island, lamb) Online Games:
