### Maths

This term in maths we will be learning more about fractions and decimals, specifically understanding how to convert improper fractions to mixed numbers.

### Writing

This term in writing, we will be learning to persuade our reader to travel with a holiday brochure and then informing our reader by writing a diary entry.

### RE

This term in RE we will be learning about Christianity, understanding some key beliefs and whether Communion is a celebration or an act of remembrance.

### PSHE
