As part of the curriculum, children will have daily spelling sessions where they will explore the spelling rule and have time to practise the words from the spelling list. At the end of the 2 -week unit, they will be 'quizzed' on the 8 listed words plus 2 mystery words that follow the fortnightly rule. They will have the chance to receive praise points during the quiz. Some children may be given a different list of words to take home that their teacher believes will support their individual learning journey. # How can I practise my spellings at home? 

Here are some useful ideas, games and web links to help your child practise their spellings at home.

5. Acrostic Poems - Create an acrostic poem for 5 of your words. Example: snow: Soft and fluffy, Never warm, Open the door, Wade in the cold
6. Make a Wordsearch - Make a wordsearch using a grid of all your spelling words. Come back and find your words.
7. Look, Cover, Write, Check - Look at the spelling Cover the spelling up Write it down Check to see if it's correct
8. Highlight it! - Write the words using a different colour for the parts that follow the same pattern or rule (e.g. silent letters: Knight, Knee, island, lamb) Online Games:
