Reading

This term we will be reading *The Last Bear*, by Hannah Gold. This heartwarming story, looks at the plight of the polar bear and links with our topic on 'Climate Change and Our Planet'.



Maths

We will be learning about shape, position and direction – including the perimeter and area of shapes, classifying and measuring angles in shapes, coordinates and translation.

RE

This term we will learning about Islam and what helps Muslims to live a good life. We will be learning about the pillars of Islam, the purpose of the two angels and times of celebration.

Writing

We will be learning to entertain through *Mr Lessmore's Flying Books*. A story of one man's love for reading and his hope and dreams for future readers.

We will be writing to persuade through a nonchronological report on plastic pollution and the effects of global warming on our seas.

<u>Science</u>

In Science we will be looking at properties and changes of materials. This will link to our understanding of climate change as we experiment and film the melting of ice to represent the polar ice caps and conduct a balloon experiment to understand the burning of fossil fuels.

PSHE

Our topic is *Healthy Me* and we will be learning about ways in which we can keep our minds and bodies healthy and active.

<u>Geography</u>

In Geography, we will be learning about America with a particular focus on the human and physical geography of 5 very different areas. We will then create our own biomes in boxes alongside a presentation on the iPads.

French

We will be learning how to tell the time in French and say what happens at different parts of the day.



PE

We will be developing our skills as cricket players and we will be enjoying learning alongside a visiting coach.

Art

In art we will be looking at Frieda Kahlo and drawing inspiration from a courageous lady, who battled against all odds to paint.



Music
