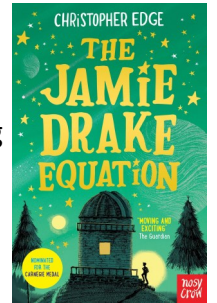
Church. We hope you all enjoyed it.

On the theme of space and courage, we have looked at the Disney Pixar film *La Luna*, the song *And Still I Rise*.

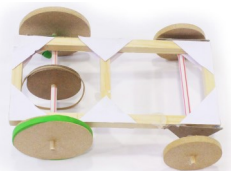


Neveah V (5S)
