Audits and OFSTED: The last two weeks of last term were extremely busy in school. We had an external consultancy company come in to a do our annual full day audit on our safeguarding and this was followed a week later by OFSTED visiting for our ungraded 2 day inspection. While we do not have the full OFSTEd report yet, both visits were successful and reinforced what makes Frimley so special. To thank the children for all their hard work and positivity during the inspection, they can wear MUFTI to school on Friday. As mentioned in my previous letter, please can they make sure it is something appropriate for doing physical activities in as we are doing our "Sports for Champions" sponsored event on that day too! A few quotes to share from our safeguarding audit:

> "It was clear throughout this review there is a strong culture of safeguarding at this school. The DSL and team of DDSLs work closely as a team in relation to all aspects of school provision that relate to safeguarding and child protection. Their knowledge of safeguarding matters is strong and record keeping is detailed with evidence of inter-agency working. The DSL and DDSLs demonstrate an empathetic and compassionate approach to the pupils and have strong communication with all staff in order to prioritise the child. The School is able to articulate and evidence Frimley's whole school approach to safeguarding."

"It is clear from the visit that governance is strong in regard to safeguarding. The school is well supported by a dedicated governor who visits the school regularly, providing both challenge and support."

"It is clear that pupils at Frimley Church of England Junior School feel safe and supported. They all feel there are adults at the School they can, and would, report concerns to, including about a friend, where necessary. They are confident they would be listened to, that all adults in the School are approachable, and that they are educated about how to keep themselves Safe."
