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PPA Cover

The year 6 teachers will have their PPA time every Thursday afternoon in Autumn 1. In this time your child will be taught by Mrs Chappelow, Mrs Whiting or Mrs Williams.

These lessons will usually be on a three-week rotation so your child will have three weeks in a row of one of the areas and then classes will swap over.



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The behaviour system

Our emphasis remains on:

- Celebrating the successes of our children
- Focusing on positivity; the praising and reinforcement of good behaviour and good work ethic
- Closely linking praise with our school values
- Earning rewards, both individually and collaboratively

We have a set of **Golden Rules**, again linked to our school values.

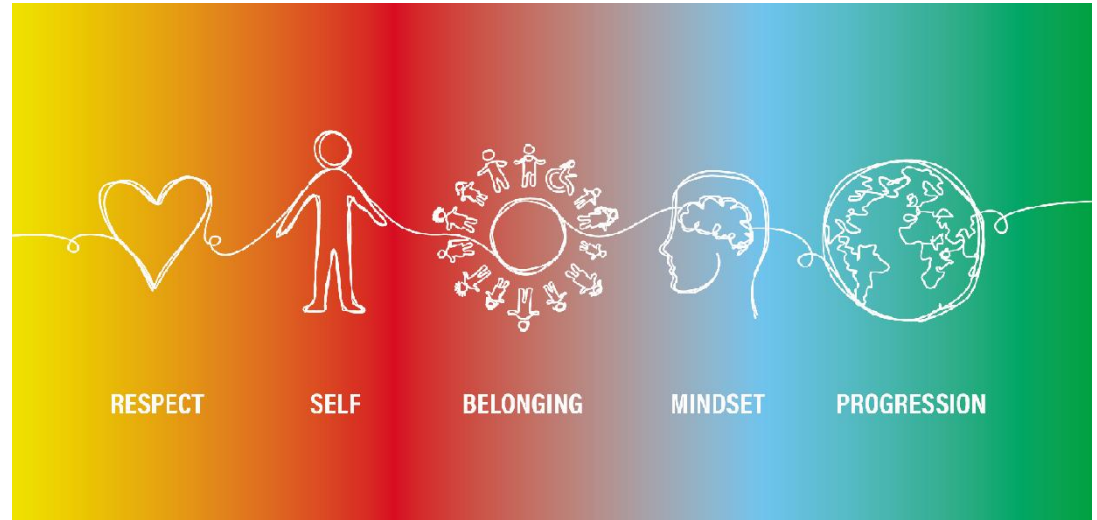
Children will continue to earn points for themselves and their House teams. These are called **Praise Points**.



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Lifelong Learners...

The Frimley Learner passport supports the development of the attributes required to be a Frimley Learner. The passport aims to encapsulate who your child is, captures their achievements throughout the year, encourages self-reflection and celebrates their successes.



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Frimley Learner Passport

Children work towards becoming an Ultimate Frimley Learner by demonstrating the different attributes inside and outside of school.

With the teacher, they sign off when they feel they have achieved a particular task. When they have had 5 activities signed off (in an attribute), they then complete 2 extended reflection tasks.

When all attributes have been completed, the child earns the Ultimate Frimley Learner badge.



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Homework



Boom Reader – read for at least 10 minutes 3x a week (to an adult) and record on Boom Reader

Times Tables Rockstars – 15 minutes weekly

Spelling lists – 2 weekly focus – lists were sent out last week

Home learning is set every Monday. To be completed by the following Monday.

All children have their log in details.



Why do we set homework?



- develops independence,
- develops good learning habits,
- helps children to remember things,
- can improve time management and organisation,
- develops positive attitudes towards learning- learning occurs beyond the classroom,
- gives children additional time to learn and remember things,
- and has many other benefits...

Evidence tells us that children who do homework make on average **3+ months more progress** than their peers.

How you can help:

- Have a dedicated space for your child to do homework and structures help- make it the same time each week if possible.
- Praise your child for their efforts.
- Contact your child's teacher if you are concerned about any aspect of homework.



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PE and Sport



Children need to wear their full PE kit to school (both outdoor and indoor) on our PE days.

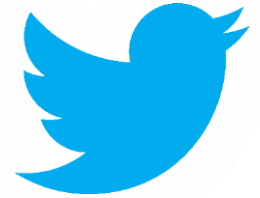
