Dear Parents & Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that we have booked our trip to Butser Farm to engage the pupils in our Stone Age to Iron Age topic. It will be on Wednesday 12th January and we will be travelling by coach. In view of the time of year, which is likely to be very cold, children need to be dressed appropriately! As the site is situated on the side of a windy hill, children **must** wear the correct clothing as we will be outside, in the elements, all day.

- **Footwear** should be **old** trainers and 2 pairs of socks. If we have had rain, footwear will still need to be old trainers and **NOT wellingtons** because the cold seeps through them (do not worry about bringing a change of shoes as it is all outdoors)
- **Clothing: 2 layers** of trousers/tights/leggings – 2 pairs of socks and then many layers on top – vest, t shirt, long sleeve top, jumper and then a waterproof jacket to protect them from the elements
- **Scarves, gloves and hats will also be vital!**

It is very important that the children have correct attire, it will be cold!

All children will need a packed lunch, a snack and 2 drinks; in a rucksack with their name on. In a bid to be more eco-friendly this year, we are trying to discourage bringing single-use plastics and encourage families to 'Reduce, Re-use, Recycle'- extra brownie points to those with the most eco-friendly lunches! Children will not require any money, as we will not be visiting the shop: the children will be bringing home their own crafts made, at no extra cost. The cost of the trip is £23.50 and payment should be made on www.scopay.com by Monday 4th January 2022.

We shall be leaving at around 9am and aiming to return at 3.15pm, traffic permitting. The journey is approximately one hour. Please ensure your child has taken travel sickness pills, if required and please inform the class teacher if your child has any issues with travelling by coach.

If you have any questions or require clarification please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.
