Frimley Church of England Junior School – FREE SCHOOL MEAL ELIGIBILITY & PUPIL PREMIUM



Completion of this form enables us to check for Free School Meal Eligibility and also whether the school can claim additional money (Pupil Premium) from the government.

Pupil Premium is additional funding given to schools for pupils who have been registered as being entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) at any point in the last 6 years. Schools receive this funding to support their eligible pupils and narrow the attainment gap between them and their peers. Further information about how the school spends these monies can be found on the school website.

Free School Meals can be provided to junior school children if they meet the eligibility criteria. All infant school children are automatically eligible for Free School Meals from September 2014.

We urge you to complete this form even if your child does not have school meals, as this will enable the school to claim additional funding.

Eligibility Criteria

Parents may not have to pay for school lunches if they receive any of the following:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided they are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Working Tax Credit 'run-on' – the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit with a household annual income below £7,400
