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Enrichment

Is now be made up of 3 lessons:

- Art and DT- Mrs Payne
- Enrichment- Mrs Chappelow
- Music and French - Mrs Whiting



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Enrichment

Enrichment time will be every Thursday morning or afternoon.

Enrichment lessons will be on a three week rotation, so your child will have three weeks in a row of one of the areas and then classes will swap over.



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Painting shirt or apron

Children will take part in art lessons at various points throughout the year.

Please could your child bring in a named old shirt or apron to use during these lessons to help keep their uniform clean. These can be kept in school throughout the year.



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Year 3 Phonics and Reading

- In class, children will continue to build upon their phonics knowledge gained in their previous schools.
- At Frimley, we use Essential Letters and Sounds (ELS) to support reading and spelling across the school.
- Some children, who may need additional support, will attend a phonics intervention group with Mrs Phillips, and will be allocated a decodable reading book in addition to their colour book banded book.
- If your child receives one of these books, it is really important that they read this book as it will reinforce the learning covered in their group.

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PE and Sport

Children need to wear their full PE kit to school (both outdoor and indoor) on our PE days.

PE is on a **Monday and Friday**.

Please ensure jewellery is removed on PE days, or if your child has to wear earrings please ensure they are taped over.



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Swimming

This year, swimming lessons will be taught in a half-termly block. Your child's class teacher will be present at the swimming lessons.

For Year 3, swimming lessons will be in Summer 2 and swimming life skills will be in the Spring Term.

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The behaviour system

Our emphasis remains on:

- Celebrating the successes of our children
- Focusing on positivity; the praising and reinforcement of good behaviour and good work ethic
- Closely linking praise with our school values
- Earning rewards, both individually and collaboratively

We have a set of **Golden Rules**, again linked to our school values.

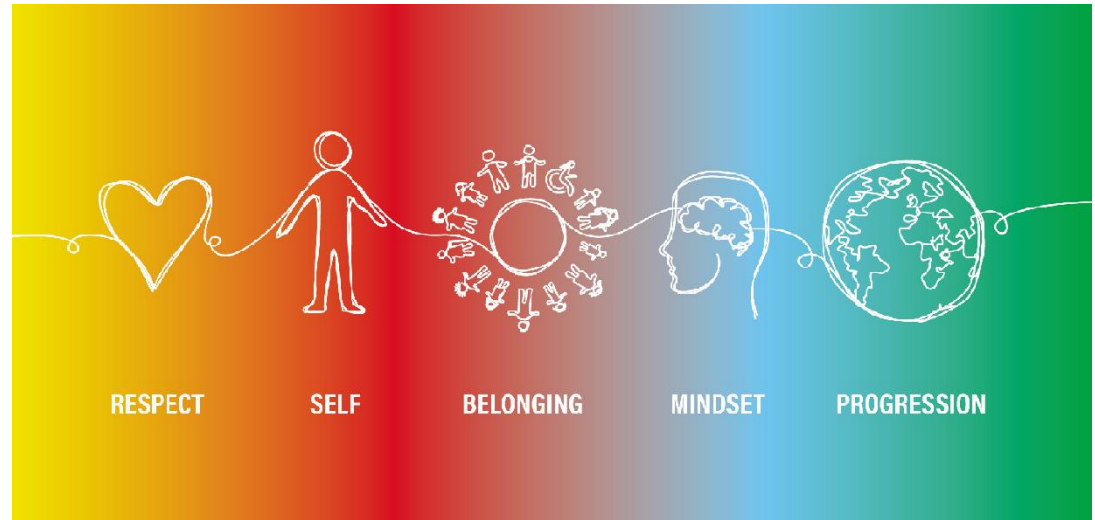
Children will continue to earn points for themselves and their House teams. These are called **Praise Points**.



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Lifelong Learners...

The Frimley Learner passport supports the development of the attributes required to be a Frimley Learner. The passport aims to encapsulate who your child is, captures their achievements throughout the year, encourages self-reflection and celebrates their successes.



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Frimley Learner Passport

Children work towards becoming an Ultimate Frimley Learner by demonstrating the different attributes inside and outside of school.

With the teacher, they sign off when they feel they have achieved a particular task. When they have had 3 activities signed off (in an attribute), they then complete both extended reflection tasks.

When all attributes have been completed, the child earns the Ultimate Frimley Learner badge.

Set every Monday. To be completed by the following Monday.

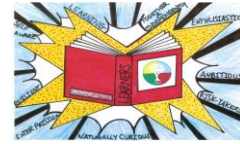
All children will be given their log in details in their reading diary.

Read a book linked to your topic and review it

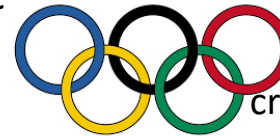

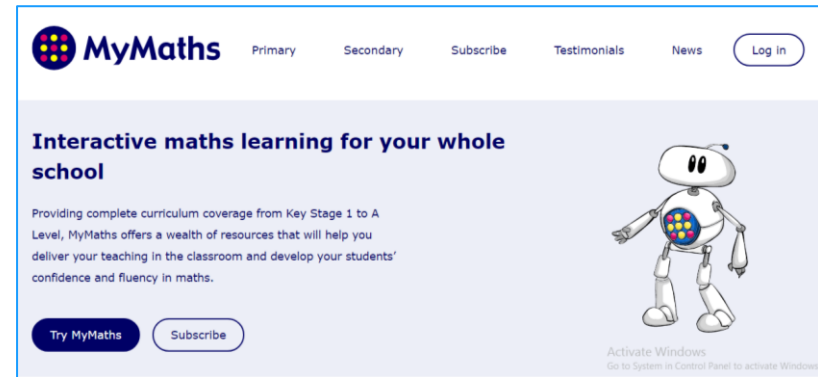

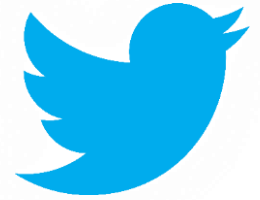
