Hi,

We hope the children have settled into after school club and are enjoying the activities on offer, each afternoon we see their confidence grow as they try different activities or play with other year groups. They're in great hands with Phoebe, Elisa and myself - Mrs Osborne!

The basis of the club is primarily to give you peace of mind while also providing the children with a space to dream big - they want to make pom poms and turn them into dog toys - *We can have a go!* They want to make a felt purse but can't remember how to sew - *we're here to help!* We regularly cycle through lots of new craft ideas and games each term, your child may have come home with Hama beads, keyrings or pom poms to name some things they've had fun making - This half term we have lots more for them to do with a focus on Winter/Christmas so do keep a look out for our activity poster when you come to collect.
